Summer Reading Requirements: Students entering grades Kindergarten through 6th grade will have one required summer reading book to be completed before the first day of school. This book will be utilized for discussion and beginning Language Arts assignments. Students should also read one additional book of his/her choice from the suggested reading list. The attached Book Form must be completed by the student for the selected book reading and submitted to the teacher on Friday, August 11, 2017. A parent signature is required.
