Summer Assignments

You will be creating 3 DRAWINGS over the summer.

Each drawing must:

- 1. Use EBONY and 6B pencils and light 3H, 2B pencils, soft pastel/oil oastel or colored pencil for one drawing.
- 2. Avoid the 5 nos of composition: nothing centered, no floating objects same size, no triangles in corners, nothing to one side, nothing lined up top or bottom.
- 3. Nothing smaller than 11" by 14" and nothing larger than 24" by 36".
- 4. Darker in FOREGROUND and LIGHTER in the distance.
- 5. VARY textures!
- 6. Reflecting light on edge of objects.
- 7. Shading in direction of form.
- 8. Light source or SOURCES.
- 9. Nothing straight on. Looking UP or LOOKING DOWN.







#3 Draw a body in COLOR using colored PENCIL

Create 7 BOARDS that represent the Elements of Art:




