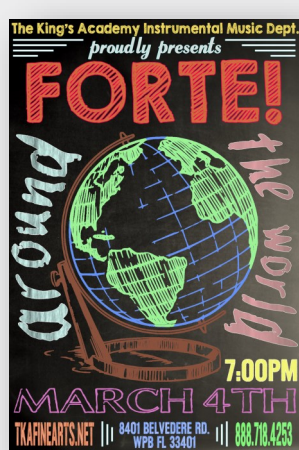

accomplishments.

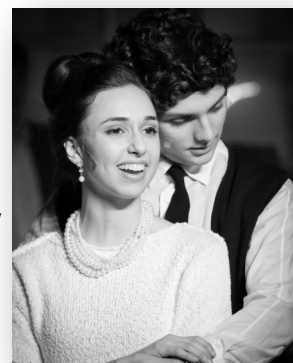
Competition Cheer Team 5th in State!
