Boys Golf Brings Home National Championship!

Congratulations to Coach Ross Cash and the Varsity Boys Golf Team for winning the 2016 Antigua National High School Golf Invitational in Scottsdale, Arizona. The team shot a school record 281 in the final round defeating 22 other teams from a field including Utah, Arizona, Texas, Florida, Wyoming, Illinois, and Canada which had won a combined 65 state championships and 5 national titles. The Lions won by 11 strokes. Senior Andrew Kozan was the individual champion, with Alex Vogelsong and Logan Othmer also in the top 5.
