Choose fiction or non-fiction books that reflect interest and reading ability.

Check with your local library branch or bookstore for book ideas or reading incentive programs.

Remember, if you read the required book early in the summer, please review it carefully before returning to school in August.

Students will complete an in-class project for the required reading with their homeroom teacher. A completed book form for their second book is required by **Friday**, **August 11**, **2017** (the second day of school).
