Last week the Lions won the Regional Championship in an 'instant classic' game. They trailed First Academy of Orlando 9-0 at halftime but clawed their way into the lead 16-15 late in the fourth quarter. The euphoria disappeared quickly as First Academy completed a 35 yard touchdown pass on what appeared to be their final fourth down with less than 30 seconds to play. The Lions quickly re-gathered themselves after the kick off, as QB Justin Wake connected 66 yards with Cory Croteau on the first play from scrimmage to score the game-tying touchdown with just 11 seconds remaining.
