

## Aviation Scholarship Application

## Who Can Apply:

Juniors interested in entering or currently enrolled in TKA's Aviation Program with the goal of earning their pilot's license.

## Requirements:

- Eligible applicants must be full-time, on-campus domestic TKA students who have attended TKA for a minimum of 2 years, with a minimum weighted GPA of 3.5. All candidates must submit a copy of their transcript. Copies can be obtained from Mrs. Watford in the High School office.
- Students may begin training at age 16, but must be 17 by the end of the course. Specific course requirements are detailed on the attached TKA Aviation Program summary.
- The Confidential Teacher Recommendation form (attached) must be completed by a current TKA High School teacher and submitted to Dr. Hoffman by Monday, October 21, at 3:30 p.m.
- Applicants should write a brief summary below describing how the Aviation Program will fit into their schedule.
- Applicants will also submit a 1-2 page typed essay describing why they are seeking entry into the Aviation Program and why they desire to become a pilot.
- Completed applications should be returned to Dr. Hoffman by Monday, October 21, at 3:30 p.m. No submissions will be accepted after this date. A panel of administrators and faculty will review applications and make recommendations.
- The successful candidate selected will be eligible to receive a generous financial award toward one of the two TKA Aviation Program options. Additional costs are required. (Please see attached fees and descriptions.)
- Please note that the student will have to repay amount used if not progressing in a semester.
