Biblical Philosophy and Worldview, is a required semester course for the rising 11<sup>Th</sup> grade student that is designed to introduce students to world religions and six major worldviews that are commonly held throughout the world. In Bible III - Biblical Philosophy and Worldview, the principles and resulting practices of Christianity, Islam, Secular Humanism, Marxist/Leninism, New Age Spiritualism (Pantheism), and Postmodernism are presented and discussed through the lens of God's Word. The course material actively seeks to cover the ethical, theological, psychological, social, political, economic, and biological implications of these worldviews. The purpose of the class is to challenge students to understand the influence of ideas in the world and to gain a spiritual foundation based on God's truth.
