The Management of COVID-19

Suspected case of COVID-19 in student*

If student is sent to the Clinic, student will be immediately isolated and sent home.

Parent should contact physician for guidance. COVID-19 testing will be encouraged.

If student has siblings at TKA, siblings must self-isolate at home for 10 days.

Potentially affected rooms will be cleaned and sanitized.

Student receives results from COVID-19 test.

Student does not take a COVID-19 test.

Student must be

If student tests negative for COVID-19, they may return to school after being fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications. Siblings may return immediately.

out of school for 10 days from symptom onset and fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications.

If student tests positive for COVID-19, follow confirmed case process.

Confirmed case of COVID-19 in student

Student must isolate at home and complete a daily symptom checklist that is provided by the school for 10 days from symptom onset or a positive test result.

Health Department will be notified of single case so we can support risk assessment and follow up.

Health Department and Medical Director will undertake an assessment through contact tracing to determine if any contacts in the setting need to self-isolate at home for 10 days and/or if testing is recommended.

If further suspected or confirmed cases occur, they need to isolate for 10 days from when symptoms started. Any siblings would need to isolate for 10 days at this point.

Once the 10-day isolation period is completed and student has been symptom free without fever reducing medication for 24 hours, student will contact school nurse for teleconference screening prior to returning to campus.

*A similar protocol is in place for faculty and staff.

Confirmed cases of COVID-19 in two or more students in the same group/class

The King's Academy nursing staff will notify the Health Department and Medical Directors if more positive cases arise.

Medical Directors to work with Health Department to support risk assessment and contact tracing.

Ensure students isolate at home for 10 days from beginning of symptoms and the rest of household isolates for 10 days.

Advise that all suspected cases get tested.

The Health Department and Medical Directors will determine if a classroom or campus closure is necessary.

The Health Department and School administrators will provide information to support outbreak communications.

Note: TKA will follow health and reporting protocol as directed by the Florida Department of Health and in conjunction with the latest CDC guidelines.
